Interpretation

- Calprotectin is a calcium-binding protein found within neutrophils which influx into the bowel during inflammation.
- The levels of the protein are high in cases of Inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD) but not in non-inflammatory bowel diseases e.g. Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS), therefore this test can help to differentiate between the two diseases.
- False positive calprotectin results associated with non steroidal anti inflammatory drugs (NSAIDS), Aspirin, liver cirrhosis and should be correlated with clinical and other investigation. False negative results were associated mainly with celiac disease or intestinal Giardiasis.
- The test result should be interpreted in conjunction with other clinical and laboratory parameters in making individual patient management decision.
