Dengue virus is a RNA virus that has been classified into four serotypes (DENV-1, DENV-2, DENV-3 and DENV-4).

This test is for qualitative detection and typing of dengue virus serotypes specific RNA (1, 2, 3 and 4) from human serum or plasma using real time reverse transcription PCR assay.

Dengue serotype 2 (DEN-2) is the most prevalent serotype over the past 50 years in India but serotypes 3 and 4 have appeared in some epidemics as well. Test results to be correlated with all clinical and laboratory findings.
