Protocol used: Dual platform enumeration of CD19/CD20^{POSITIVE} cells using BD FACS Canto – II (CD45-V500-A, CD19-PE-Cy7-A & CD20-V450-A antibodies) on BD FACSDiva software and Beckman coulter DXH-800 Hematology analyzer.

Descriptive summary:


Flow cytometric immunophenotyping using CD45-V500-A, CD19-PE-Cy7-A & CD20-V450-A antibodies were used in a stepwise sequential gating with forward-side scatter and CD45-side scatter analysis. A minimum of 50,000 events was used for analysis.
