Comment

- Fungal culture results should always be correlated with the clinical symptoms of the patient, serologic and other laboratory tests
- Antifungal therapy before collection of sample or inappropriate sample type may interfere with the growth of fungus.
- Initiation of antifungal therapy is always subjected to clinical parameters and risk factors of the patient.
- Discrepancies in the microscopic result (KOH) and culture of fungus may exist in case of fungus being a colonizer or in the initial stages of fungal infection.
